Peter drumming up a roll of classics

A FEAST of classical music is coming to St Annes.

Fylde Sinfonia will perform a variety of classical music at the United Reformed Church and are sure to be a big hit with local audiences.

Pieces by Verdi and Elgar are to feature in the concert, including such scores as La Forza del Destino and the Cello Concerto in E minor.

The concert is being conducted by Peter Buckley, who took charge of the orchestra four years ago.

Since then, Fylde Sinfonia have enjoyed regular success and have become a popular orchestra in the area.

Peter established himself as kit drummer with the Lytham St Annes Light Orchestra and timpanist/percussionist with the Blackpool Symphony Orchestra, where he continues to play.

In the 1980s, Peter was the kit drummer for the Methodist Association of Youth Clubs National Orchestra and regularly performed in major venues such as The Albert Hall and Royal Festival Hall in London.

By contrast, he also drummed through several seasons in a Blackpool night club.

This month's concert is taking place on Saturday, March 15 and starts at 7:30pm

Tickets cost £16 for adults and £5 for senior citizens. Admission is free for under 16s.
